Notice of resuming service of Civil Process

On May 18, 2020, the Hancock County Sheriff's Office resumed limited service of civil papers that we had in our possession prior to the Covid-19 shut down. This resumption began after a meeting with our civil people, the Court Clerk, and a District Court Judge.

On June 1, 2020, we will begin accepting new papers to be served with the following conditions: Papers will **Only** be accepted by mail and with the appropriate deposit. Dated papers will be accepted but with the understanding that if the court is not open when the date occurs, you will be notified by **THE COURT** of a new date. Rush and same day service will be accepted on a case by case basis, taking our ability to serve them into consideration.

This is just the next step in being able to serve your paperwork in a timely manner taking in consideration the safety of our staff. We hope that things very soon will return to normal.
